## **Academic Advising**

The Academic Advising services are designed to assist students focused plans that help them reach their academic goals while taking into account their career and personal plans. Students can meet with an Academic Advisor or Counselor to help them map out a plan to earn their associate degree or to make sure they are on track to transfer to a college or university to earn a bachelor's degree.
