Students must read and understand the terms of the Academic Forgiveness Application below:

- Students may seek Academic Forgiveness only once and it cannot be reversed. Should this Academic Forgiveness be granted, the affected courses will be marked by an asterisk (*) symbol on the transcript, and will be excluded from the student's GPA computation. Forgiven grades are not removed from the student's record and remain as a part of the official transcript.
- "Academic Forgiveness" is a Schoolcraft College policy. Transfer institutions may or may not acknowledge Academic Forgiveness.
- Courses for which Academic Forgiveness is sought must be at least ten (10) calendar years old.
- A student must have completed at least an additional twelve (12) credit hours at or above a cumulative GPA of 2.0 before the Academic Forgiveness designation will be applied to the student transcript.
- Academic Forgiveness can be granted for one semester or session's worth of work (regardless of the number of credits) OR a maximum of 12 credit hours total across several semesters/sessions.
- Courses that are granted the Academic Forgiveness designation cannot be used to fulfill graduation requirements or for special program entry.
